#### **CNSC** Inspection

- **Dates:** Start on site April 15, 2024; estimated 4 days (full inspection will be from April 12-24)
- Context: This inspection will focus on the Management System SCA (Safety and Control Area) as identified in TRIUMF's Licence Condition Handbook. This covers all the processes, policies, procedures – and their accompanying records – relevant to the TRIUMF Quality Manual (Document-611).
- Scope: This inspection's purpose is to verify the implementation of processes/policies put in place by TRIUMF to address findings from the inspection of the Management System SCA conducted in February 2021.
- Criticality: TRIUMF must demonstrate compliance to CSA N286-12 (Management system requirements for nuclear facilities). This is a regulatory requirement and is critical for our license and ongoing operations, and failure to demonstrate compliance could jeopardize our licence or risk major operational impacts, including (in a worst-case scenario) the potential shut-down of all TRIUMF operations.

#### Today's seminar:

Speaker: Simon Viel (Carleton U)

Title: Searches for new physics with noble liquids at SNOLAB

Abstract: The Standard Model of Particle Physics, which so successfully predicts interactions of elementary particles down to the smallest scales observed, is known to be an incomplete theory. In this talk, two types of searches for physics beyond the Standard Model will be discussed, both with noble liquids as the detection medium. First, I will present the latest results from experiments looking for dark matter interactions with liquid argon targets: the DEAP-3600 experiment located at SNOLAB, and plans toward the next-generation experiments DarkSide-20k and ARGO. Then, I will talk about the nEXO experiment, also planned to be located at SNOLAB, that will look for neutrinoless double beta decay in liquid xenon to determine whether neutrinos could be their own antiparticles. Finally, I will show developments in single-photon detection technology enabling nEXO and ARGO, with potential applications outside the field.
